Rules

All matches will be played by ERF rules:
„best of 5“ to 11, win by 2.

A **two minutes rest period** is allowed between each game.

Warmup time is **5 minutes** in singles
and **4 minutes** in doubles.

Time-outs—for non-mandatory garments or equipment, the referee should assess a time out. If a player/team does not have any remaining, a referee timeout may be granted to uphold the integrity of the game. Two minutes are allowed to replace any garment and 30 seconds are allowed to replace or adjust equipment.

Note: the glove is not a mandatory piece of equipment and may only be replaced during a time out or between games.

During a game each player in singles or each side in doubles, either while serving or receiving may request a timeout. Each timeout may not exceed **60 seconds**. No more than 1 time-out is allowed per game.

An injured player is allowed a cumulative total of up to **15 minutes** during a match. If the injured player is not able to resume play after this time period, the match is awarded to the opponent(s).

The ERF will form an Appeals Committee consisting of 5 persons. A player can ask the tournament director to assemble the Appeals committee about any a misinterpretation or misapplication of a rules, after asking the referee and the tournament director for an explanation and/or review.

Injuries

If a player does not show up for more than one match of the team competition, he/she cannot continue participating in the individual competition in the second phase of the draw.

Uniforms

All athletes must wear country identification while competing in team and individual competition (name and/or emblem) on the backs of their shirts clearly visible from the outside to the referee, spectators, and the media.

Senior and junior player are asked to follow the uniform policy as well.

In doubles, shorts and skirts must match relative to style, material, colors, graphics, and/or emblems.
